Last week was a busy day in Making Day. The Mural is looking fantastic and the students are working hard at attaching all the plastic lids.

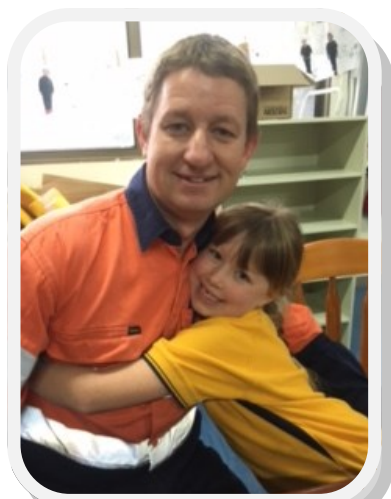
The cooking group were busy making Lemon Slice for the Father's Day Breakfast on Friday. Word has it this was very popular amongst our dads.
