Families are invited to come and assist in a Working Bee.


Please put the morning of Sunday 18th May aside (9-12) to come and help us install our new chicken coop enclosure and other general tasks around the school.

Work hard. Be kind. Dream big

Our whole school is aiming to have 80% of students with 95% attendance during 2025.

That is a maximum of 10 days of absences over the year.

How many days have you missed?

Could they have been avoided?

Could they have been a half day absence instead?

Can we help in anyway?

I'm happy to report that after 37 days of school (as of 21st March) we have had an average of 2.4 absences days per student. If we continue at this rate we will have our best attendance data in many years. Teachers have been reporting that the flow of lessons has been less interrupted as the continuity of learning is able to be maintained.

At present we have 65% of students who have had 95% attendance. Our aim is for 80% of students.


Kinder photos will be available with the school on Friday 9th May. Please arrive at 12.30.
