Music

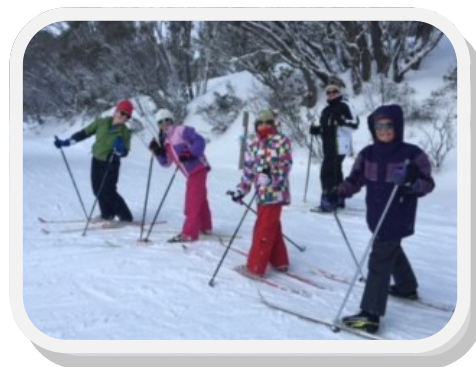
Our music program with Conrad started last Wednesday and will continue weekly in Term 3. Conrad was impressed that the students had remembered a lot from last year.

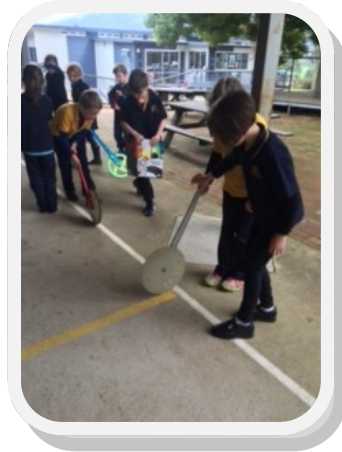
